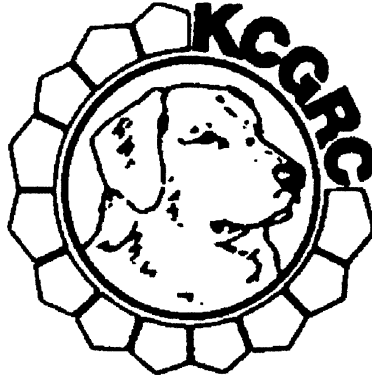

BEST OF BREED

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

The following Non-Regular Classes (Single Dog Entries) will be provided both days.

Veteran – A class for dogs and bitches at least eight (8) years of age. Class will be divided by sex.

Veteran Class winners may compete for Best of Breed if otherwise undefeated at this event. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be exhibited in veterans classes, and subsequently, in the Best of Breed class at shows where judging does not proceed beyond Best of Breed. The Veteran may be neutered/spayed if and only if Veteran Class is the only class entered.

Hunting Retriever – A class for dogs and bitches who have earned an AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter, or Master Hunter title. Class will be divided by sex. Hunting Class winners may compete for Best of Breed if otherwise undefeated at this event.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL – OPEN TO ALL BREEDS (Golden Retrievers first) – Limit 50 Entries Per Trial

A qualifying score is required for all prizes in the regular classes but is not required for prizes in the non-regular classes. “Dog” when applied here means either sex.

Refund Policy: Refund of entry fees for bitches entered in obedience that come in season after the closing date for entries for these shows will be made only upon written certification by a licensed veterinarian. Refund amount will be the entry fee paid less \$5.00 per day. All claims for such refunds shall be made with the show secretary not later than ½ hour prior to the start of any obedience judging the day of the show.

RALLY CLASS REQUIREMENTS – OPEN TO ALL BREEDS (Golden Retrievers first) – Limit 20 Entries

Rally Novice A Class: Dogs competing in this class may not have won an AKC Rally Novice (RN) title or any AKC obedience title. A handler must own the dog entered or be a member of the owner’s household or immediate family. The handler may not have previously handled any dog that has earned an AKC rally title or any AKC obedience title. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. After a dog earns the Rally Novice (RN) title, it may continue to compete in this class for 60 days. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

Rally Novice B Class: Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

Rally Advanced A Class: For dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (RA) title or any AKC obedience title. A handler must own the dog entered or be a member of the owner’s household or immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. After a dog earns the Rally Advanced (RA) title, it may continue to compete in this class for 60 days. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial. The dog’s jump height shall be given on the entry form.

Rally Advanced B Class: For dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (RA) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial. The dog’s jump height shall be given on the entry form.

Rally Excellent A Class: For dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (RE) title or any AKC obedience title. A handler must own the dog entered or be a member of the owner’s household or immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. After earning the Rally Excellent (RE) title, a dog may continue to compete in this class for 60 days. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial. The dog’s jump height shall be given on the entry form.

The Rally Excellent B Class: For dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (RE) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial. The dog’s jump height shall be given on the entry form .

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES – OPEN TO GOLDEN RETRIEVERS ONLY

The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to any purebred Golden Retriever, at least six (6) months of age and under eighteen (18) months of age, and entered in any of the Regular Classes at the Specialty Show at which these Sweepstakes are held. Champions of Record are not eligible. The handler of a Sweepstakes exhibit must be limited to the owner, co-owner, breeder, or a member of their immediate family as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made.

Open to all Golden Retrievers 8 years of age and older on the day of the show. Neutered dogs and Spayed bitches may be entered in this class. Dogs need not be entered in any other class in the show. However, if they win, they may not be considered for Best of Breed unless they are entered in Best of Breed competition. The handler of a Sweepstakes or Veteran Sweepstakes must be limited to the owner, co-owner, breeder or member of the immediate family as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date of this show.

- ✓ NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- ✓ NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS – For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- ✓ NOVICE SENIOR CLASS – For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- ✓ OPEN JUNIOR CLASS – For Boys and Girls at least 12 years of age on the day of the who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.
- ✓ OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS – For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place award in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.
- ✓ OPEN SENIOR CLASS – For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

THE WINNER OF A THIRD FIRST PLACE IN EACH NOVICE CLASS SHALL AUTOMATICALLY BECOME ELIGIBLE TO ENTER IN THE CORRESPONDING OPEN CLASS AT THE SHOW, PROVIDED THE WIN IS THE THIRD FIRST PLACE AWARD WITH COMPETITION AND FURTHER PROVIDED THERE ARE ONE OR MORE JUNIOR HANDLERS COMPETING IN THAT OPEN CLASS.

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended. It is the expectation that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same.

GROOMING & CRATING

A building directly across the parking lot from the show building will be available for grooming. This building offers air-conditioned indoor space for exhibitors. Additionally, the Arena building, with no air conditioning, will be open for grooming. A dog bathing area will be set up outside of the Arena Building. The grooming buildings will be open for set up on Friday evening, June 19th from 5:00-8:00 p.m.

The Show Building #21 will comfortably fit conformation and obedience rings, spectators and very limited crating space. This building is air-conditioned. No grooming and no X-pens will be allowed in this building. No space can be reserved with cones, mats, ropes, chairs, etc. It will be available for early crate set up on Friday evening from 6:00-8:00 p.m.

RV PARKING

KCGRC will host a social hour during the Best of Breed competition during the show on Saturday. All exhibitors are invited to enjoy hors d'oeuvres and refreshments.

PHOTOGRAPHS

The show photographer will offer digital imaging whereby the winners may select their photos on site. Payment will be required at the time of ordering by check or cash.

SHOW AND GO

A show-and-go will be conducted Friday evening, June 19 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the show site. All handlers (whether entered in the trial or not) may participate. This event is open to any breed of dog. Fee \$5.00 payable at the show-and-go.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries w/checks drawn on U.S. Accounts or with International money orders in U.S. funds.

Telephone, telegraph, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without Agreements and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

No entry fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specified any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signature.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
