- No entries will be accepted by phone, fax or email except through LabTestedOnline.com
- Hand delivered entries will not be accepted for the first 24 hours after the opening date and time.
- Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. **Mail requiring signature will be returned to sender – NO EXCEPTIONS.**

- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- **Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC agreement are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial (AKC Rule CH 14, Sec 4).
- **Move-ups (Prior to set of trials):** Accepted until 6:00 pm, Monday, October 18, 2021 by email or by U.S. mail
- **Move-ups (Day-to-Day):** KCGRC will accept day-to-day move-ups. The request for moving up must be made in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary not later than the day preceding the event.
- **Please check your entries!** Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed.
- **E-mail confirmations** will be sent to those listing a legible e-mail address on the entry form. If you would like to receive your entry status by US mail prior to the issuance of the judging schedule at closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard along with your entry.
- **Email confirmation receipt:** Please notify the trial secretary if an initial confirmation is not received within a reasonable time.

WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES AFTER THE CLOSING DATE/TIME

A waiting list will be kept until Monday, October 18, 2021, 6:00 pm, to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 50 entries for each day will be placed on the wait list. Any entries received by the closing date/time that are withdrawn before the waiting list deadline will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. If an entry is cancelled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by the waiting list closing date will receive a full refund.

AKC Jump Height Cards -

- You are no longer required to submit your height card with your entry.
- If a dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked indicating that the dog needs to be measured prior to running.

Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.

A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted in the Trial. Entry fees, less \$10.00 administrative fee for each day entered, will be refunded for bitches coming in season after the closing date. The Trial Secretary must receive written veterinarian notification by letter prior to the start of the trial.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will conform to current of the *Regulations for Agility Trials*. All classes will take place indoors.
Ring size will be one 98' x 100' ring.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Qualifying Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score in each titling class. Rosettes will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height in each titling class.

1 st Place.....	Blue	4 th Place.....	White

A Rosette will be awarded to all dog/handler teams finishing a title. A jump drive with KCGRC QQ logo will be given for each QQ earned (qualifying score in both Master Standard and Master Jumpers with Weaves). A MACH Ribbon & MACH Bar will be awarded to each dog earning a MACH title and a PACH Ribbon & PACH Bar will be awarded to each dog earning a PACH title. A worker raffle will be held each day with a \$25.00 gas card given to the winner each day.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

- **BUILDING:** The building is climate controlled; indoor restrooms.
- **SET-UP:** No set up on Thursday
- **CRATES** may be left overnight; however, the Kansas City Golden Retriever Club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the event site. No dogs allowed overnight in the building. **No X-pens will be allowed.** Please conserve crate space and welcome our new Novice exhibitors. Crating will be tight at this site and there may be some crating in vehicles required, as well as outdoor crating under easy-ups. Please use wire crates and stack your crates whenever possible. More information about crating set-up will be included in the confirmation letter.
- **Electronic Timing:** Electronic timing will be used at these trials.
- **PARKING:** There is close parking, but please park conservatively.
- **RV PARKING:** **Overnight RV parking** is not allowed at the trial site. There are RV parks in close proximity to the show site in the Jackson County Parks System at Lake Jacomo. The Lake Jacomo campsite area is approximately 5 minutes from the trial site. - **Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
