# CONFORMATION CLASSIFICATION – OPEN TO GOLDEN RETRIEVERS ONLY

#### **REGULAR CLASSES**

The following Regular Classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

Puppy, 6 Mos. & Under 9 Mos. Bred-By-Exhibitor Puppy, 9 Mos. & Under 12 Mos. American Bred

12 Mos. & Under 18 Mos. Open
Novice Winners
Amateur-Owner Handler Best Of Breed

#### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES**

The following Non-Regular Classes (Single Dog Entries) will be provided.

**Veteran** – Dogs and bitches at least eight (8) years and under ten (10) years. Class will be divided by sex. **Veteran** – Dogs and bitches at least ten (10) years and under twelve (12) years. Class will be divided by sex.

**Veteran** – Dogs and bitches at least twelve (12) years and up. Class will be divided by sex.

Veteran Class winners may compete for Best of Breed if otherwise undefeated at this event. Neutered
dogs and spayed bitches may be exhibited in veteran class, and subsequently, in the Best of Breed class
at shows where judging does not proceed beyond Best of Breed. The Veteran may be neutered/spayed
if and only if Veteran Class is the only class entered.

**Hunting Retriever** – Dogs and bitches who have earned an AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter, or Master Hunter Title. Class will be divided by sex.

Hunting Class winners may compete for Best of Breed if otherwise undefeated at this event.

#### **AKC OWNER-HANDLED SERIES**

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series allows Owner-Handlers to compete head-to-head against other Owner-Handlers. It not only makes showing more fun, but it also actually increases the chances for winning at Breed, Group and Best in Show levels. Participation is easy:

- Simply check the owner-handled eligibility box on this show's entry form
- No additional entry fees
- Owner-handled dogs eligible to compete in Best of Breed including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of non-regular classes can participate
- The AKC Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. This series of special competitions will be offered at select dog shows across the country.
- All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers meet the requirements for this competition. The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
- Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog.
- Dogs must be handled throughout the competition by an eligible owner. Professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any competition during the entire show.
- Dogs owned or exhibited by professional handlers, their assistants and members of their household are not eligible to participate.

#### OBEDIENCE / RALLY

- KCGRC will accept entries of Golden Retrievers first, according to Option 2 in the AKC Obedience Rules
   Regulations Manual, then from all breeds until the entry limit of obedience entries per day is reached.
   Capacity of the facility limits obedience and rally not to exceed 8 hours of judging time per day per judge.
- Open to all AKC Recognized Breeds and All-American Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program, with Golden Retrievers, receiving first priority (According to Option 2 in the AKC Obedience Regulations).
- A qualifying score is required for all prizes in the regular classes but is not required for prizes in the nonregular classes. "Dog" when applied here means either sex.
- All dogs will be judged in jump height order in all obedience and rally classes in which jumps are used.
- Judging will be in ascending order beginning at 4 inches. \* Transfers are allowed per AKC regulations.

#### **OBEDIENCE & RALLY REFUND POLICY:**

Refund of entry fees for bitches entered in Obedience and/or Rally that come in season after the closing date for entries for these shows will be made only upon written certification by a licensed veterinarian. Refund amount will be the entry fee(s) paid less \$10.00 per day. All claims for such refunds shall be made

with the show secretary not later than  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour prior to the start of any obedience or rally judging the day of the show.

#### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION - OPEN TO GOLDEN RETRIEVERS ONLY

- ✓ NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- ✓ NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- ✓ NOVICE SENIOR CLASS For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
- ✓ OPEN JUNIOR CLASS For Boys and Girls at least 12 years of age on the day of the who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.
- ✓ OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place award in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.
- ✓ OPEN SENIOR CLASS For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.
- ✓ MASTER For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition.
- ✓ BEST JUNIOR AWARD

THE WINNER OF A THIRD FIRST PLACE IN EACH NOVICE CLASS SHALL AUTOMATICALLY BECOME ELIGIBLE TO ENTER IN THE CORRESPONDING OPEN CLASS AT THE SHOW, PROVIDED THE WIN IS THE THIRD FIRST PLACE AWARD WITH COMPETITION AND FURTHER PROVIDED THERE ARE ONE OR MORE JUNIOR HANDLERS COMPETING IN THAT OPEN CLASS.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler NUMBER on each entry and information for Junior Showmanship classes entered on front & back of entry form. You may obtain your Junior Identification number by calling the AKC, Event Record Dept, (212) 696-8281.

### PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES - OPEN TO GOLDEN RETRIEVERS ONLY

The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to any purebred Golden Retriever, at least six (6) months of age and under eighteen (18) months of age and entered in any of the Regular Classes at the Specialty Show at which these Sweepstakes are held. Champions of Record are not eligible. The handler of a Sweepstakes exhibit must be limited to the owner, co-owner, breeder, or a member of their immediate family as they are listed on file with the American Kennel Club as of the closing date for the show for which the Sweepstakes entry is being made.

#### SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

- The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- The Kansas City Golden Retriever Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or
  injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to
  children.
- The Kansas City Golden Retriever Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Kansas City Golden Retriever Club or any official thereof.
- All dogs must <u>be on leash at all times</u> when on trial grounds except when showing in the ring.
- The Kansas City Golden Retriever Club may cancel or delay this event in extreme weather conditions.

#### **REFUNDS**

- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Event Committee.
- Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally Trials. Refund of entry fees for bitches come in season after the closing date for these shows will be made only upon written certification by a licensed veterinarian. Refund amount will be the entry fee paid less \$10.00 per day. All claims for such refunds shall be made with the show secretary not later than ½ hour prior to the start of any obedience or rally judging the day of the show.

#### **RINGSIDE**

- Dogs need to be present only for scheduled judging. Consult the judging program for time of judging.
- Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when the class is to be judged. The show-giving Club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through the public address system, runners or stewards for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

#### **ENTRIES**

- Entries not on official AKC forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are not acceptable.
- Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Owners are responsible for
  errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded for such errors or cancellation of entries after the published
  closing date.
- Please remember to mail your entries early to avoid possible postal delays!
- NOTE: Please waive signature requirement when sending entries by Express Mail, Fed Ex, etc. Entries will not be accepted when a signature is required.

Conformation and Obedience/Rally rings are in separate rooms.

### "New" SITE INFORMATION

- BUILDING HOURS: The building will open at 7:00 AM and will be closed thirty minutes after the end of the last class each day. NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT OVERNIGHT IN THE BUILDING Building will be locked and no security will be provided. Crates/Equipment may be left overnight; however, the Kansas City Golden Retriever Club nor Leavenworth KS County Fairgrounds will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. (There will be no free crating next to the trial rings.)
- **POWER:** Forced Air Dryers are currently allowed inside the East Room of the Administration Building and outdoors. Power will be provided with a registered grooming reservation for inside and outside the Administration Building. Limited electricity is available in West Room for Rally/OB; battery fans are welcome. Complimentary grooming space and complimentary rally/obedience crating is available in the adjacent Pavilion. The Pavilion has no electricity, and no generators are allowed under the Pavilion. Generators are allowed outdoors on the show grounds.
- **COVID GUIDELINES:** KCGRC will be following all Local, State and Federal guidelines which will be updated and detailed fully in the Judging Program after entries close.
